



COVID-19 VACCINE UPDATE FOR OUR PATIENTS

Dear Patients:

As mentioned in our last email communication, we want to make sure you have the newest information possible regarding COVID-19 vaccine availability. Over the weekend, new guidelines for vaccine eligibility were announced. In Virginia, the Governor has recently petitioned to move onto the next phase of vaccine distribution (Group 1B), and each jurisdiction is working on methods to get the vaccine distributed via their local Health Department.
